## SIENNANET Big Changes

Siennanet is becoming part of the TownSquare (TownSq) family. What does this mean for residents? Well, it means a whole new look as well as new features, new tools, and a new way to log in. As part of this change, after logging in, residents will now have a unique resident portal from which they can pay their assessments, view documents and submit online forms. Transitioning to the new platform will take place the weekend of March 9 and we expect residents to be able to log on Tuesday, March 12. This transition also means that residents will need to re-establish their log in information, passwords and emails (for electronic communications, like the E-News). The initial process of logging in will require residents to use their Association account number and property zip code. Detailed instructions will be mailed to residents prior to March 12 - watch your mailbox for an envelope from the Association.

## Dear Dougie

**What are the main issues that Community Standards Coordinators are looking for in the Spring months?**

- Sandy H, Bees Creek

As we head into Spring and weather improves, landscaping maintenance becomes a priority. Inspectors will be checking to make sure that lawns are properly mowed and edged. During these months, a good guideline is to mow the yard every 7-10 days. Residents will also need to keep their yards free of excessive clover and weeds.

Another key issue is egregious mold/mildew/dirt stains on the home exterior, windows, chimneys, driveways, and sidewalks. Power washing can help remove these areas. Inspectors will also be looking for any major fence repairs that are needed. For example, if the fence is missing or has several broken pickets the resident needs to replace these. Fences should also be straight and upright. *By working together, we can keep Sienna looking gorgeous!*



## CALL FOR VOLUNTEERS - Deed Restriction Enforcement Process Task Force



The SPRAI and SPCAI Boards have approved the formation of a new Association Task Force - the *Deed Restriction Enforcement Process* Task Force - that will begin this Spring. This new task force will consist of 15 members including: 1 Village Rep from each of the 7 Villages, 1 member of the Hearing Advisory Committee, and 7 property owners that will ideally represent each of the 7 Villages. Applications will be accepted through March 31 - via email only - and then the Boards will approve the members to serve on the Task Force. It is anticipated that the Task Force will meet monthly between April - August, 2019 with a goal to make a recommendation to the Boards on any proposed changes, if needed, to the deed restriction enforcement process by September 2019.

**The Task Force Volunteer Application can be found on Siennanet (landing page) and should be submitted to Lisa Cox at [lisac@clubsienna.com](mailto:lisac@clubsienna.com), by March 31.** Applications that are dropped off or mailed to the Association office will not be considered.

The Association regularly evaluates our deed restriction (DR) enforcement process as it relates to the frequency and method of property drives. One of the Association's Business Plan items for 2019 is to evaluate the DR enforcement process and implement any change. Several changes have been made to the process over the last few years, but Staff believes engaging with the community for feedback will hopefully help in clarifying current process practices and identifying further changes, if needed/recommended. In addition to the process, the Task Force will also address the approach as it relates to the level of enforcement - the balance of strict vs moderate or lenient adherence to the community's guidelines. Previously, evaluation of the process and approach was based on feedback from our resident volunteer committees and boards, along with 'best practices' of similar large master-planned communities. Prior community feedback has included responses via annual surveys, Association meetings, and other communication methods (emails, calls, and even social media comments).
